

Minutes of the Select Board Meeting, October 25, 2016

Halloween

Howard entertained a motion to designate October 31, 2016 as Halloween in Plainfield per recommendation of the Recreation Committee. The motion, moved by Phil and seconded by Leslie, was unanimously approved.

Appointments/Resignations

The Board accepted Penn Moulton's resignation from the Planning Board and as Municipal Hearing Officer with deep regret.

A letter of interest in serving on the Buildings Committee was received from Erik Burcroff; this appointment should be made by the Moderator.

The 2017 Cultural Council Grant contract was signed.

A thank you letter to Dario Coletta for agreeing to move the rocks adjacent to the road on Pleasant Street was signed by the Board.

The Accountant noted the FY'17 Buildings Repair Account will exceed the appropriation by \$550.00. Repairs to the Salt Shed cost \$15,000.00 and there are \$550.00 of unforeseen costs to repair the alarm system at 315 Main Street. Paula will ask for Finance Committee approval to use the Reserve Fund for the overage. MassDot provided information concerning recent changes to speed limit regulations under Chapter 90, Sec. 17 and 18.
