- Consider Rooftop PV potential Public Safety Building
 - o Determine USDA Approval (potentially conditional upon structural analysis)
 - Roof Load Structural Analysis PE (estimated \$2K)
 - Chris Vreeland Aaron Simms (SunBug) recommendation
 - Have required architectural drawings and original structural certification data
 - Star Building System (prefab metal frame manufacturer)
 - Probably won't meet current (9th edition) Building Code, even w/o considering air cleaner additions
 - Procurement RFP versus Bid Specification
 - Leverett example of Ground Mount PV procurement using RFP
 - Hawley example of rooftop PV Bid specification
 - New FO facility being added to plot separate building, new meter
- Highway Garage Insulation ECM
 - Guardian Energy audit visit Dec 13 with BE Retrofit weatherization subcontractor
 - Brad Airey proposals Feb 6:
 - Fiberglass batt insulation (roof 8", walls 5.5"), Overhead door weather stripping upgrade.
 - Walls and Ceiling = \$99,979. / Walls only= \$54,038
 - Option: Insulate roof from top in conjunction with new roof
 - MMC Specialty Roofing proposal (via Jeff Prost) \$45,300 for 1.5" polyisocyanurate insulation / EPDM membrane roof
 - GC funds can be used for cost of insulation portion
 - Energia agrees to supply a "wall only" proposal using rigid foam board vs sprayed foam
- META Grant (\$12,500) to fund Level II audits of remaining buildings
