Coordinator Update

The additional \$1,500 we requested in the annual budget was approved at the Annual Town Meeting on May 6th. This brings our yearly amount to \$8,000. If there is any money remaining for the current fiscal year, we must spend it before June 30th or lose it.

Newsletter: We had hoped to get funding for our newsletter as a line item in the State budget but it was not approved. Discussion followed of ideas for getting out our news. Maybe we could buy a page in The Plainfield Post - since it comes out every two weeks, we wouldn't have a whole month's worth of news so maybe one page would be adequate. Another idea is to use the library as a place to disseminate information of interest to seniors. Currently, Peg Whalen is preparing a grant (in addition to the AARP grant already submitted) called Enhancing Digital Literacy for Older Adults which could provide the Consortium with up to \$100,000. If this should happen, we would need librarian Denise Sessions's support to display flyers and pamphlets that provide information about the services and equipment.

Polly will be purchasing a new laptop and printer with money leftover in this year's SIG (Service Incentive Grant) grant. Chesterfield has older laptops to loan to seniors.

A Consortium Memory Conference is scheduled for June 22nd from 10-3 in Chesterfield, run by Jan Gibeau, Director of the Consortium and the COA in Chesterfield and Rebecca Star, a geriatrician from Cooley-Dickinson.

After May 22nd, Polly's training for posting on the Consortium website will begin.
