November 2022, minutes presentation/approval

1. Coordinator Update – missed 12-7-22 meeting due to carpal tunnel surgery
 - Survey of computer needs in households 60+ will be mailed in January. The consortium meeting will be the envelope stuffing party. The results of the survey will determine how \$40,000 of the sig grant will be allocated. \$120 will be going to Caleb for 3 hours of once-a-month computer support through January. Funds are presently supporting Pegs work on the survey and the overall assessment of each town's needs. All remaining funds will go to supplying towns with equipment.
 - Also, HVES grant is fully funded. \$600 for multicultural events and \$350 for reducing isolation events. Judy Messer is willing to do 2 in person seasonal and art centered yoga workshops that will spend the funding. Does everyone approve?
 - One Plainfield Funds for COA...need ideas on how to spend the remaining town Covid funds (\$57,000). We will host them at our January luncheon to give them our ideas.
