- The Town of Plainfield uses a "residents only" punch card, pay-per-bag system for household waste disposal. Punch cards cost \$37.50 each and contain a total of 50 punches.
- **Punch Card Sources:** Punch cards can be purchased from the attendant at the site and from the Town Clerk.

Propane Tank Recycling

20 lb. tanks, and defective Fire extinguishers, \$ 5.00 fee or bring them to George Propane. No fee for 1 lb. propane tanks (see attendant).

• Universal Waste Recycling (see attendant)

Rechargeable batteries, button and lithium batteries, fluorescent and compact lights (spirals); mercury containing devices – thermometers, thermostats, and ballasts containing PCBs are recycled through an HRMC program. Alkaline, Carbon zinc, and zinc chloride batteries (all sizes: AAA, AA, C, D, 9- Volt and lantern) can go in the bagged trash. No Charge.

- Household Hazardous Waste (HHW): the HRMC holds an annual HHW collection each October and offers Plainfield residents the opportunity to participate in at least six other HHW collection events in the region. For more information contact HRMC.
- Free Drop Offs: Clothing and textiles, except used bed pillows and bulky comforters may be left in the Salvation Army Box. Books, CD's and DVD's may be left in the book bin. White, solid Styrofoam, and bicycle tires can be left with the attendant.

• New: Dispose of shredded paper in the trash; empty aerosol cans in with metals.
