We receive several speeding complaints, please call us with yours. It is also suggested that people adjust their speed to current construction conditions on Route 116; 20 MPH is the suggested speed in a construction zone. Complaints were also received for red lights flashing on the school bus; speeding by a school bus; school bus driving too slow and general speeding on Route 116.

Approximately 61 cell phone calls were made in September to Chief Litchfield, and Sgt. Miazga received roughly 48 cell phone calls, all related to Plainfield Police business. Twenty (20) calls were received at the station, and 7 walk-ins.
